Paracord Survival Bracelet





The 1Tac **Paracord Survival Bracelet** is the all-around must-have survival tool on the market today. Fashioned from military-grade parachute cord, the 1Tac Survival Bracelet packs a multitude of lifesaving features. It is expedition ready, super stylish and features 9' of super strong, 550 test military spec paracord.

Paracord Survival Bracelet Features:

- 9FT of 7-Strand Waterproof & Mildew Resistant Mil-Spec Parachute Cord
- Maximum Tension Resistance : 550lbs
- Stainless Steel Striker/Cutter to strike Flint Fire Rod to Create Spark & Start a Fire

To use Paracord Survival Bracelet

How to unravel Survival Bracelet:

1. Locate ends of paracord (next to clip) by finding the small singed and melted ends.
2. Pull ends to release paracord by either pulling with your fingers or use a pair of pliers and work them loose by twisting back and forth.
3. Once loose, unravel cord by undoing each knot until you end up with a continuous string. It will take approximately 2-5 min to unravel.

4 Emergency uses for the Paracord:

1. Build a shelter – tie together branches or other debris.
2. Fishing Line – cut end of cord to expose the inner strands.
3. First Aid – use as an emergency tourniquet or suture.
4. Climbing – tested at 550lbs, it can be used as a climbing tool.

How to use Fire Starter:

The fire starter can be used when paracord has been unraveled or not. A benefit of starting a fire with an unraveled bracelet is that the cord can be used as tinder for a fire by cutting a small 1 to 2 inch piece of the cord with the cutter/striker on bracelet and using the inner strands)

1. Locate the steel striker and flint fire rod on either end of the bracelet.
2. In a downward motion, strike rod with the steel striker to create a spark. Continue this motion until the spark creates a fire on your tinder.
